- Gain an understanding of the structure, roles, responsibilities, and capabilities of key government agencies with respect to cybersecurity.
- Define cybersecurity board expertise, particularly in critical infrastructure industries.
- Learn about personal cybersecurity, privacy, and physical security practices for board members.

The purpose of this program is to create an opportunity for directors to gain insights from government and industry leaders who are at the forefront of defending our nation's critical infrastructure. The academy provides a platform for engaging with peers and cybersecurity experts on key trends and practices.
